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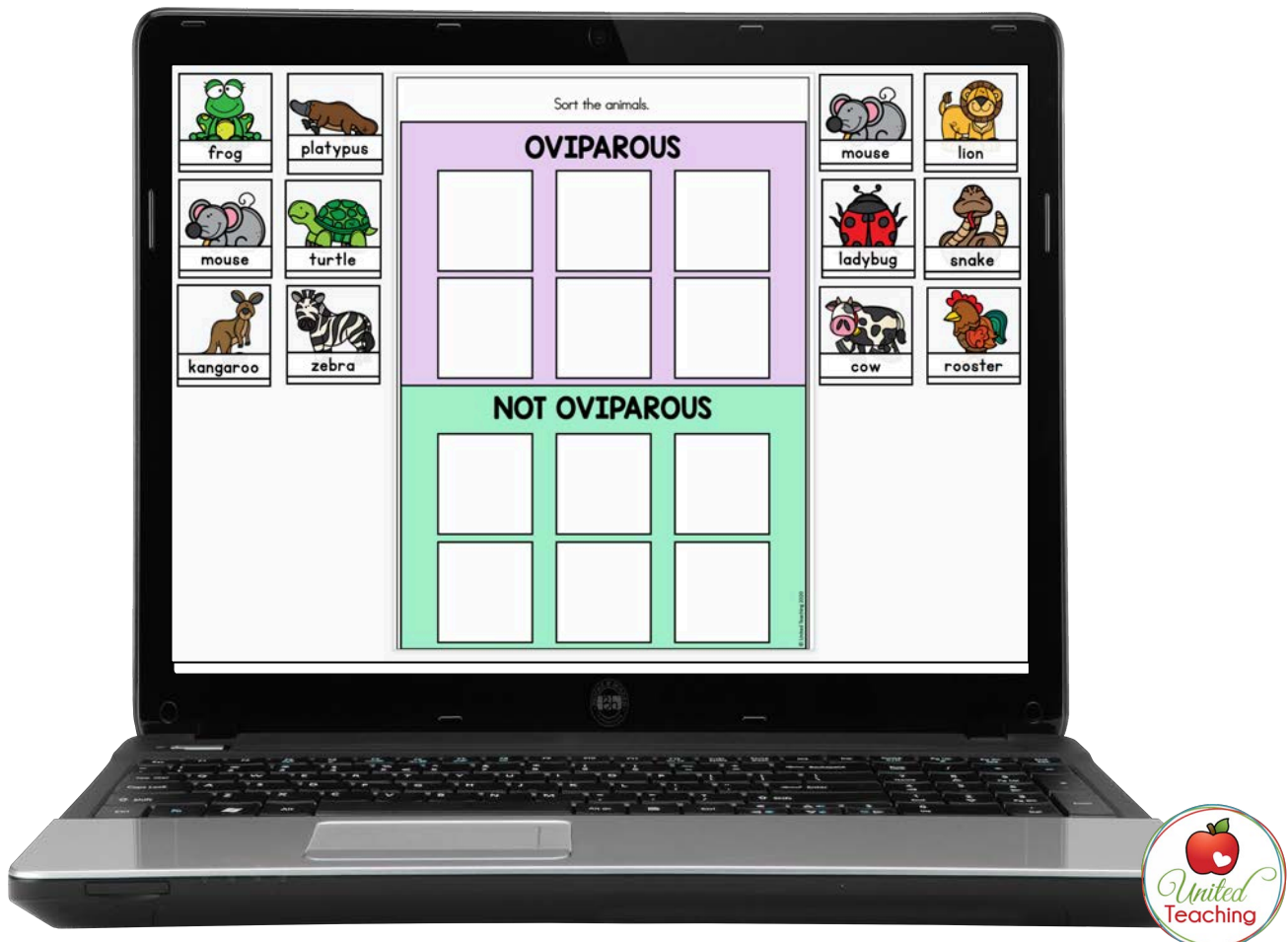
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ANIMAL CLASSIFICATION AND LIFE CYCLES

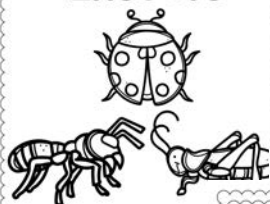


Birds



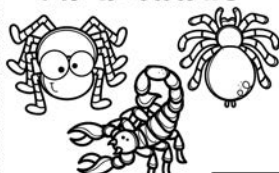
Birds are warm blooded and lay eggs. They have wings and feathers. They have two feet and two legs.

Ocean Animals




The ocean is a large body of water. Many animals live in the ocean.

Farm Animals




A farm is a place where animals are raised for food. Farm animals include cows, pigs, and sheep.
