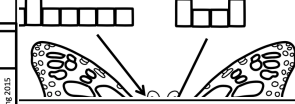

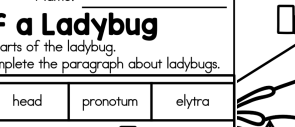

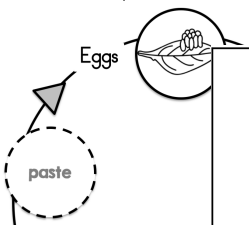

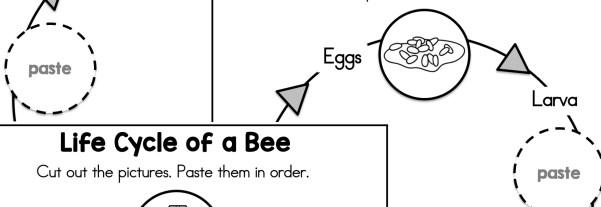
Read the passage and answer the questions below.

Ants live in colonies that can be found in ant hills, a rotted log, and even trees. The colonies have a structured social system. Queen ants are the head of the colony. They lay thousands of eggs. Male ants called 'drones' mate with the queen. The rest are female ants that don't reproduce. They are the 'workers' or 'soldiers' who find food, care for the queen and offspring, build nests, and defend the colony or attack others.

Comprehension Check Ladybugs

Read the passage and answer the questions below.

Ladybugs are a type of beetle. Ladybugs have two sets of wings. The outer set, elytra, is the hard shell used for protection, and the inner set are at it uses to fly. The color on the elytra can be yellow, orange, or red and often has small black dots on it. Ladybugs eat aphids, scale insects which harm plants. This helps protect plants.
